## A Public Place, Quite Simply, for Public Fun

This engagement involved designing a pub and meeting space as a new enclosed portion of an existing outdoor pavilion at the Flint Farmers' Market – an award-winning project also designed by FUNchitecture. The new space is an added amenity that will allow Market Tap, located in the main Flint Farmers' Market building, to avoid scheduling conflicts when the market is reserved for weddings, fundraisers or other private events.

The pub will operate as a service bar with a large walk-in cooler and dishwashing station, and will feature indoor seating for roughly 75 patrons. Food service will be provided through four overhead doors, perfectly sized to accommodate food truck vendors on days the market is closed. The design solution calls for using materials that will complement the existing market pavilion.

An outdoor "yard" space will seat an additional 75 people year-round and provides ample space for further socializing with cornhole courts, fire pits, a dining patio with turf dance area and a stage for live music. The area will be fenced per State Liquor Control Commission requirements, but openly visible so that visitors approaching from the north or south can see the FUN activities and events going on.
